English - The Write Stuff

The Explorer - Katherine Rundell

This term our key text is this adventure story set in the Amazon rainforest.

Through role play, discussion and sentence construction, the children will learn how to write an effective adventure story - using devices including; metaphors, similes, dialogue and amazing adjectives to build tension and excitement for their readers.

Later in the term, we will use this same text to write in a different genre.

Maths - Maths Mastery (White Rose Maths)

Each class follows a slightly different programme of coverage depending on the year group(s). All year group objectives are covered during the academic year however.

Palmer Class - a focus this term on roman numerals, numbers to 1,000,000, rounding and negative numbers before looking at adding and subtracting numbers with more than 4 digits.

Zephaniah Class - a focus on roman numerals, numbers to 10,000,000, negative numbers, rounding and the four operations. Reasoning with known facts is also a key skill covered this term.

Rundell Class - a focus on numbers to 10,000,000, negative numbers, square & cube numbers, factors, nultiples and prime numbers prior to division.
