English

This term's writing unit will be based on 'The True Story Of The Little Pigs.' A traditional tale with a *twist*, this is a fiction unit where the children will be taught a range of variety of compositional devices, as well as developing and practising their transcription skills (spelling and handwriting). Throughout the unit, the children will learn how to write their own traditional tale and will have to come up with their own twists!

Maths

In maths, our initial focus will be on shape. The children will revisit and extend their knowledge of both 2D and 3D shapes, learning to describe and classify them using precise mathematical language. We will then move to strengthening their foundation knowledge of number and place value:
Year 3 - understand and represent numbers to 1000
Year 4 - understand and represent numbers to 10,000
This includes comparing and rounding numbers.

Learning Means The World - Hot Off The Press!

This unit explores the history and development of print with a focus on comics and cartoons. We will then learn all about animation. The unit incorporates history, art and computing. We start with the beginnings of print, exploring Gutenberg and the early printers before moving onto typefaces and cartoon prints. The animation section of the unit provides children with the opportunity to create their own animated films/



RE- How do Hindus understand who God is?

We learn that most Hindus believe that there is one supreme Deity or God – Brahman. We will be learning about the aum/om symbol. Children will learn about Murtis, which are colourful figures and pictures of the deities, found at Hindu shrines and temples. These figures usually form the focus for prayer, as they are believed to be filled with the spirit of the God they represent. Learning will be through a multi sensory approach including Art.
