Movement and Ball skills Led by MNR coach.

In PE we will be looking at different ways we move our bodies.

We will be looking at different types of movement, such as running, hopping and skipping. We will then move onto ball skills and work on throwing and catching a ball.



RE - ODBE Schools

We will be looking at different religions and how different festivals are celebrated in different religions. We will look how Diwali is celebrated by Hindus and how Christmas is celebrated by Christians.

Maths - Maths Mastery (White Rose Maths)

In Maths we will be looking at subsisting to 5, ensuring that the children can identify numbers, 1 to 5 without counting them and seeing them in different forms and knowing what the number is instantly. We will also be ordering numbers to 10 and identifying what number comes before and after any given number to 10.

We will then move onto shape and we will look at different kinds of shapes, such as circle, triangle, square and rectangle and identify them by how many sides they have. We will also be looking at size and ordering from smallest to largest.
