Learning Means The World -

In LMTW our new topic is: No Place like home. We will be looking at homes from all over the world. We will be looking at different types of homes, such as flats, house boats and cabins. We will be exploring the local area to look at different types of homes in Henley and asking the children what their favourite room in their house is. We will also be looking at different parts of a house and what materials they are made from

To finish the year our last topic is What on Earth? This is a topic in which we look at how we can look after the earth, what we can do to help things grow, what materials we can recycle and how we can recycle and what we can do to look after the planet we live on.

English -

Our Write Stuff: This term we will be looking at information books and finding out different information about animals that live under the sea. We will be producing our own fact files about animals that live under the sea.

We are working on always using capital letters, finger spaces and a full stop in our writing. We will also be using our phonics knowledge to write unknown words.

PE

The children will be learning all about throwing and catching balls, how to use a bat and coordination on a Monday with the PE coach

Maths

In Maths in EYFS this term, we will be focusing on 2D and 3D shapes. We will be looking at how many sides and corners, 2D shapes have. We will also be looking at consolidating our understanding of numbers 1-20. Ensuring we can identify missing numbers. We will also be looking at odd and even numbers and identifying why a number is odd and why a number is even. We will also be working on additions and subtractions to 20.

RE -

The children will be learning about Spring. We will be looking at how different animals are born in spring and how flowers grow and new life starts. We will be getting some caterpillars in the classroom to show how they grow into Butterflies, which will be a cross-curricular activity with RE and Science.
